The Ohio Renaissance Festival offers its patrons unique, quality services and products. Our annual attendance continues to increase year after year. Guests are transported back to the 16th century to experience world renowned entertainment and our nine themed weekends.

Please complete the vendor application and include it with your proposal. Your proposal should be in a binder, contain pictures and prices of all of your products, a brief bio about yourself and/or your business, and a listing of any faires or festivals you have done or will be doing this year. The jury meets the third Tuesday of each month February through May. Within two weeks after the jury meeting you will be notified, in writing, of your acceptance or denial.

If accepted to ORF you will receive a packet containing our rules & regulations, our building and tent standards, your acceptance letter, a map with your location clearly marked, and your contract. You will have approximately 30 days to pay your vendor fees. The contract we offer becomes null and void if your required fees are not paid within the allotted time.

Our basic fees are:

Spot guarantee	\$300 (deducted from first day's payout)
Electricity	Not available in all spaces
Service Charge	\$175
Harveysburg Business License	\$25
Percentage Payment to Festival based on gross sales payable daily at close of festival.	

Camping

RVs	\$1,000 run of festival
Tent camping	\$100 run of festival, or \$50 per weekend

All concession tent and/or structure designs must be approved by the Food and Beverage Director and Site Manager. You will be required to provide your own tent/structure, floor, and tables. All food vendors are expected to have their booths open every day the festival is open for the allotted hours of operation.

Vendors will be required to wear Renaissance themed attire, i.e. pirate shirts, peasant shirts, or period dress of your choosing to be approved by Food and Beverage Director. Patterns for shirts can be supplied if needed.
