



## Festival Fun Facts

- To date, **over 3.24 million people** have entered the gates to experience a full day of 16<sup>th</sup> Century fun.
- Nearly **400 gallons of beer and ale** are enjoyed per day at the festival. That translates to **over 7,500 gallons** a season!
- **Over 768,000 pounds of turkey** have been consumed to date. That's **928 tons** of giant roasted turkey legs!
- Each year **5,000 pounds of steak** and **15,000 skewers** are used for Steak-on-a-Stake.
- **10 to 14 tons of dirt** is used each year to produce the famous mud in the Muditorium for the Mudde Show. That's nearly **406 tons** to date!
- **Tens of thousands of artisan demonstrations** have been performed in the Medieval Marketplace.
- **Over 500 couples have married** at the festival and countless others have renewed vows or proposed marriage.
- **570 lances are used** each season by the jousting troupe Knights of Valour during the Tournament Jousts. Each lance is **11 feet long**.
- Sir Shanton's armor weighs **140 pounds**.
- **Over 72,500 collectible tankards** have been sold to date. A total of 29 different color schemes, designs, and stamps.
- The role of **Queen Elizabeth** has been **portrayed by five different women** in 29 years.
- The **Tiki Bar's mast** is **65 feet tall**.
- **Street Cast** have dedicated over **3,500 of rehearsal hours** in 29 years.
